TERMS & CONDITIONS:

- All artwork must demonstrate the re-use and recycling of waste.
- Entrants will be notified of competition results by mail/telephone.
- The results of the competition will be announced to local media.
- All entrants grant permission to the organisers to publish &/or broadcast the names and photographs of the finalists and the winners through print and electronic media.
- Judges and their immediate families are not eligible to enter.
- Judges decision is final, no correspondence will be entered into.
- Artworks and copyright remain the property of the entrant.
- A brief description of your composition, the materials and inspiration of your artwork will be included and forwarded to your coordinator with your artwork prior to display. (MAXIMUM OF HALF A4 PAGE).

ALL ARTWORK MUST:

- Be safe for public exhibition.
- Not exceed a size limit: 2 dimensional – 2x2 metres & 3 dimensional – 2x2x2 metres.
- Not exceed a weight limit of 40kgs.
- Be exhibition ready. If the artwork is to be hung a hanging system must be included (it can be very simple).

All artwork must be delivered to your local participating council, artists are responsible for packaging of their own artworks for transport to the Regional and collected once the exhibition has ended. For details please contact the local Waste to Art Coordinator. The cost and means of transport to the local exhibition are the responsibility of the entrant. If you are a winner at the local exhibition your work will be transported to a Regional Exhibition. The cost of transport will be covered by NetWaste. The organisers will take all reasonable care in handling and dealing with works submitted, however the organisers will not be responsible for any loss or damage incurred to any of the artworks or materials.
